Do NOT Buy These

What	Why
500 spine	Too weak/flexible for ~61lb effective — poor flight, inconsistent
30" arrows	Too short — point may pull behind rest at full draw (safety risk)
Arrows rated "20-50lb"	Your ~61lb effective draw is outside their stated safe range
Fiberglass arrows	Not rated for this draw weight — risk of shattering
