This is tagged at the "class" in the HTML.

If you are using this for a Hubl module, include a class area for that module. Most likely you will put it at the beginning or first <div> for that module.

In the .css you will include the following:

```
.row {  
  display: grid !important;  
  grid-template-columns: repeat(4, 1fr) !important;  
}  
  
@media(max-width: 992px){  
  .row {  
    grid-template-columns: repeat(3, 1fr) !important;  
  }  
}  
  
@media(max-width: 600px){  
  .row {  
    grid-template-columns: repeat(2, 1fr) !important;  
  }  
}  
  
@media(max-width: 480px){  
  .row {  
    grid-template-columns: 1fr;  
  }  
}
```

`repeat(4, 1fr)` You can adjust this to as many columns as needed `repeat(3, 1fr)` or, `repeat(4, 1fr)` or whatever.
