

# Troubleshooting Odoo |

## Docker permissions:

### Docker permissions:

FYI: On first setup, main/root directory is set to "root"

```
drwxr-xr-x  5 root          root          4096 Nov 21 11:44 odoo1/
```

Inside your root directory, Your main website directory will be set to root. Change it. Go into the docker container and get the user ID number. In my case it was 102. Exit the container and chown 102:102 your directory so that the container has its own permissions.

```
chown 102:102
```

```
drwxr-xr-x  4 systemd-network systemd-journal 4096 Nov 21 11:46 odoo-web-data/
```

### Data Base:

The data base should be fine if it looks like:

```
drwx----- 19 lxd          root          4096 Nov 21 11:46 odoodb/
```

### Extra-Addons:

```
drwxr-xr-x 17 root          root          4096 Nov 21 16:51 extra-addons/
```

## Loosing connection to dashboard:

**\*\*DO NOT RESTART THE ODOO CONTAINER\*\*** After restarting the Odoo docker container, the Odoo dashboard will not connect. The site also looks messed up or, just won't load at all.

Solution 1: Delete all volume folders and start over. Permission doesn't seem to have an effect on this.
